ECLIPSE OF THE MOON MONDAY JUNE 4th June 3, 2012

I would like to remind everyone that tomorrow morning at 7:13 AM EDT we will have a partial lunar eclipse, one of two eclipses in the last two weeks, somewhat rare. The Moon will pass through the shadow of the earth giving us a partial eclipse that can be seen on the Pacific side of the planet. The zone of the eclipse will stretch from East Asia to the central parts of North America. You may be able to see it just before sunrise on Monday morning.
