We have completed our Dharma Practice Calendar (free to share) for mobile smart phones (iPhone, Android, iPad, etc.) and this application will also run on Mac and PC desktops.

It now provides not only the current Lunar practice day (tithi) and the time for the next, but also includes a list of the current two weeks with listings of the beginning of each lunar day so you can schedule your practice times. Yet another screen provides a table of the general practices that are done on the 30 lunar days.

I hope you enjoy it and feel free to send it to your friends. This is not an app that you download, but just a regular web bookmark. On your iPhone or smart phone just type into your browser:

In either case, select "Moon Time" from the menu and you will see on the screen that appears a little red icon of a dharma wheel. This will take you to list of current lunar days and their times. On that page you will see another link "About Practice Days," which will give more general details.
