

SOLAR ERUPTIONS August 9, 2010

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Here are a couple of blogs on the strong eruption of solar particles on August 1st through the 4th or so. What possible interpretation can astrologers give to this material hitting the earth?

HUGE SOLAR ERUPTION

The Sun erupted last Sunday spewing forth a huge burst of plasma into space, which is heading right toward Earth. It is a coronal mass ejection of particles which will funnel in through the north and south magnetic fields of the polar regions on Wednesday August 4th, 2010. Some have written me asking what this means. Here are some thoughts.

This is the beginning (and a strong one) of the coming solar maximum, the peak of an 11-year cycle, the point where the Sun is communicating most with us. And what does it communicate?

Can this streaming information from the Sun touch your brain, reach your heart, and connect? That would be thinking only physically. The Sun is way more than just a physical body, just as you are. If you consider yourself more than physical, consider what the Sun is. Just imagine!

When the Sun touches us, it not so much touches us where we are, but in 'who' we are. The Sun is the light in our mind whenever we remember or discover in a true sense 'who' we really are, or as the Buddhists say: when we discover the true nature of the mind. Not just all the distractions we spend most of our time on, but what those distractions distract us from and that is: the true nature of the mind. We ignore this reality and remain ignorant for the most part, and for most of the time. Correct?

So a burst of information from the Sun not only affects us magnetically and creates geomagnetic radio storms and auroras, but touches us also right where we 'are' most ourselves, inside and not just outside. Think the following through:

The process of us discovering ourselves, that is the process of 'identifying' "IS" the circulation of the Sun, the circle of the Sun. Identification IS circulation, the way the cosmos knows itself, through the galaxy, to the Sun, to the Earth, to each of us and it is ALWAYS happening. Right now it is happening even more.

All structures, like the galaxy, like the solar system, like the Sun, like the Earth, like each of us are only coherent (hang together) as long as information flows through us. When life stops, the physical is empty, empty of what? That inner information is the light in our eyes when we identify, when we discover, when we 'know'.

Identification IS circulation.

We here on earth may be at a remote distance from the galaxy center, the Sun center, the Earth center, but in the mind nothing is remote. We are the very eye and mind of the universe looking at itself, fully present when we are identifying or endlessly finding ourselves, existing and

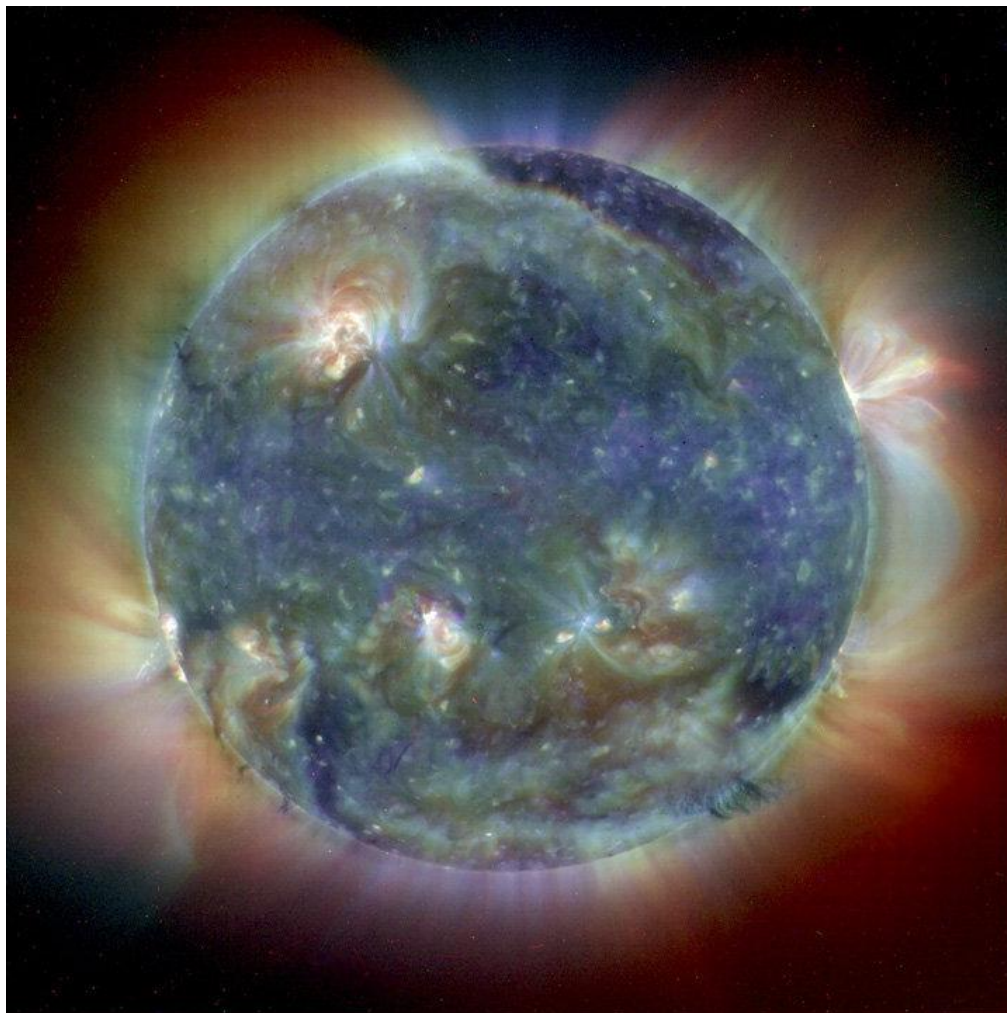
cohering ONLY by the continual process of identifying, identification. With no identification, there is nothing communicating.

I know this is abstract folks, but IF you can make sense of it, then you can flip that view that 20th Century science has laid on us, that mankind is a lonely outpost on the edge of the galaxy, which itself is on the very far edge of the supergalaxy, and so on. You know: cold, black, alone, helpless, meaningless, etc.

Instead we are, each of us, representative intelligent life, no more distant than any part of our own body is distant from being us. We live through our body, and not vice versa.

Increased solar bursts touch the "We" in us, who we are at core, so do be AWARE of inner shifts and changes, rather than look for outer effects. The inner controls the outer, and not vice versa. A change at the center controls the periphery, but not always vice versa.

Well, words cannot convey what I am pointing at, which leaves me just pointing at the reality. Can you see it?



SOLAR ERUPTIONS AND THE SELF

Some of you have questions as to how this infusion of solar plasma into our innermost self will manifest or be detected. That's a good question, so let's go over it. First of all this is very, very subtle stuff. By subtle I don't mean we are not smart enough to get it, but rather that we may not have enough awareness right now to be... AWARE of what has happened. Why? Because we are somewhat overwhelmed by the solar information. Remember this information remakes our sense of self, not just the northern lights or some radio interference.

Perhaps the best way to get a handle on it is to think back a day or so and get a fix on what your mind was like then and where you thought you were headed, as in: where WERE you headed two days ago?

Once you remember that, now ask yourself the same question tonight. Where are you headed? And has anything changed?

When a sudden infusion of solar information overwhelms our critical faculties, kind of overflowing our normal measurement tools, we can find ourselves quite easily at loose ends, struggling to remember where it was we were so surely headed only a day or two before. This is a typical example of where a flood tide of deep information may leave us. And this happens all the time, but not usually in such a dramatic way as this burst. If we rest our mind and don't strain it, we should be able to see the change between yesterday's mind and today's mind, as in: there was a change.

What was crystal clear then may find us in a bit of a fog now and hard pressed to explain it. Or our head may be pounding. In a word, we have been disoriented and it may take us a day or two to acclimatize and re-set our sails in whatever direction now makes sense to us. We literally have to regroup, reorient ourselves in what can appear as somewhat of a new situation, and find an attitude that can take or hold up to whatever the new breeze is providing.

And where we were clear before, we may be foggy now or feel like our head is all jammed up with something that obviously it will take time for us to sort through. If we panic, it only makes it worse, so the best advice I know is relax, pick up the pieces, rearrange them into a plan, and put that new plan to work. Forget about the old plan of a few days ago, although I am sure for most of us they will end up similar, subject to whatever deep change within us dictates.

I apologize if this is too abstract and I am asking you here not so much to think about it, as to take a look at where you are right now in relation to what I have written. Are you aware of it? And if so, how are you taking it?

It is like the solar blast blew our concept of our Self into a million pieces and now we are trying to pick them up and come up with a half-decent image of our self again. It goes a long way toward proving that the Buddhist concept of the self as having no true (permanent) existence is in fact true. After any implosion or radiation of solar or cosmic data it is normal to be popped out of our day-to-day groove, right out of the box, and to lose control of our more orderly self.

We can explain by saying we are upset, overwhelmed with input, just busy, or however we want to explain it, but that natural fact is that our self got a bit blasted and we are trying to glue all the pieces back in place. The image seen in many sci-fi movies of the android-whatever being blown to pieces and then somehow regenerating itself, but not entirely successfully comes to mind here. We come out different. If we look close, we can see how the self is something we

literally put together however we can. It is our supermarket basket of stuff that we are wheeling around.
